Tournament Series Details

- 30% payout to top three teams each weekend (15%/10%/5%)
- 20% reserved from each weekend for championship match (top two teams in points standing from the whole series)
- Championship match will be held after the tournament on October 16 (75% of reserved payout for first place, 25% of reserved payout for runner up)
- Double elimination bracket (best 2 of 3 games) will be used with random draw for initial team matchups
- Series points will be tallied with one point per game won throughout all three dates

General

- Be considerate of others while disposing of garbage and dispose of it properly. **Keep your campsite clean.**
- No water is available in the campground unless designated otherwise.
- Campers and guests must obey all rules in this agreement, (please see below) and must also obey all local, state, and federal laws. **Campfires must be in a fire ring (available to rent or bring your own).**
- Anyone 17 years of age or younger must be accompanied by a responsible adult or legal guardian while in the campground.
- The CCAIS reserves the right to remove any campers, without refund, for the best interest of the fairgrounds and/or other Campers/Renters.
- Any questions, issues, or concerns should be brought to the attention of the General Manager.
- **Campers and guests acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and that many public health authorities still recommend practicing social distancing, and acknowledge that they are voluntarily choosing to attend event(s) at the Calhoun County Fairgrounds and assume the risk that they may be exposed to COVID-19. CCAIS and the event organizer(s) cannot guarantee that event attendees will not become infected with COVID-19 and that attending events at the Calhoun County Fairgrounds could increase their risk.**

Campsite Rules

- One sleeping unit per site. Only one trailer or tent or RV per site
- No cutting of trees or shrubs or taking ANY wood from the fairgrounds property
- Campfires are restricted to fire rings only. This is a city ordinance and the city will enforce. A responsible adult to be attendance at all times. No trash, bottles, cans or left-over food is to be burned.
- Campsite must be cleaned before you leave
- No grilling on top of picnic tables
- Flashlights recommended after dark for your safety when going to and from restroom
- NO ATVs, Quads, DUNE BUGGY'S, or Sand Rails. All vehicles are limited to 5 MPH while in the fairgrounds and shall be limited to sound
- All Drivers MUST be 21 or older with a valid drivers license to operate carts/vehicles. Violators will lose their registration and will have to purchase a new registration upon management approval
- Campground Staff determines the rules. If management determines that someone has violated the rules or is having behavioral issues they will be asked to leave the grounds with no refunds
- We have no tolerance policy for inappropriate behavior as we are trying to maintain a family friendly atmosphere
- All alcoholic beverages must remain on your site in a secure area
- Please obey the 5 MPH speed limit for everyone's safety
- Please pick up all belongings after using Fairground facilities
 - Please report any bathroom problems to the General Manager immediately

Children

- Children under 18 years of age must never be left alone on Fairgrounds property
- Parents/guardian are responsible for their children at all times on all Fairground facilities

Pets

- No aggressive animals will be allowed
- No more than two pets per site
- Dogs must be leashed at all times
- Dogs that bark continuously will be asked to be removed from the grounds
- Clean up after your pet(s) at all times - waste must be placed in the trash
