### 2023 RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES: Slots limited to the first 50 paid registrants.

\$10.00 Entry Fee due at time of registration

- Any regular electric Power Wheel is allowed. No 4-wheeler type vehicles allowed. Child's legs must be in a compartment. Ride in not ride on!
- Age groups are as follows: 3-6 & 7-10.
- HELMETS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE POWER WHEEL.
- Bike helmets are ok.
- Motor must remain stock. The only modification the vehicle is allowed to have is up to a 12 volt lawn mower battery added which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat and the battery must be secured and sealed away from the driver.
- All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape or other flexible product for making them stay shut.
- Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking, no screws, nails or anything for extra traction can be added.
- You can add decorations like headers, etc. but they cannot reinforce the car.
- All power wheels must have a number somewhere on the power wheel.
- 4 balloons will be added to each power wheel. The contestant with the most balloons still inflated at the end of the 10-minute time period and who had actually performed during the 10 minutes will be declared the winner. Tie breaker will be determined by the judges for the best performance.
- Only one parent/guardian is allowed to stay with the child in the pit area at all times.
- One parent/guardian of each participant is required to sign a permission slip and media coverage release or child will not be able to participate
- Registration will close at 4pm the day of the event.
- Permission sheets and signups will be available all week at the fair or you may contact the below number or email for one to be sent to you.
- Ribbons to every participant and trophies to the top 3 winners of each age group

**All power wheels will be checked in at pit gate then impounded for inspections and will remain impounded until time for their event.**
